(19) And she made him sleep upon her knees; and she called for a man, and she caused him to shave off the seven locks of his head; and she began to afflict him, and his strength went from him." REVIEW SAMSON'S PAST RELATIONSHIPS

- all of your strength? ❖ BETRAYED BY WIFE 1 (Judges 14:14-20) He created a riddle ["Out of the eater came forth meat, and out of the strong came forth sweetness." and because she claimed he didn't love her, she cried for 7 days until he told her the answer to his riddle. The Philistines threatened to burn she and her father's house if she did not comply. She pressed him so much that he told her everything! She used knowledge of it to betray his trust.
- LAID WITH AN HARLOT (Judges 16:1)
- ❖ TRICKED BY DELILAH (Judges 16:18-20)

### A healthy relationship does not put us into unhealthy predicaments.

THREE TIMES DELILAH'S ACTIONS SPOKE LOUD AND CLEAR:

**JUDGES 16:9** "... Now there were men lying in wait abiding with Delilah in the chamber..."

- Samson said, "if they bind me with seven green withs that were never dried" **Verses 11-12**
- Samson said, "if they bind me fast with new ropes that never been occupied" FOOL ME ONCE, SHAME ON YOU FOOL ME TWICE, SHAME ON ME **Verses 13-14** FOOL ME THREE TIMES....
- Samson said, "if thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web"
